THIS BRAND GUIDELINE explains and outlines the proper usage of the Kahuina, Lamakū, and Māmalu logos and their applications. The purpose of this guide is to provide consistency and clarity in all communications in which the logo appears.

These logos may not be altered or redrawn in any way, including changes in typestyle, proportion, letter spacing, color or placement of the individual elements making up the logo. Changing a key graphic element, detracts from the consistency and integrity of the Kahuina, Lamakū, and Māmalu logos.

CLEAR SPACE & MINIMUM SIZE

Clear Space: A minimum of 0.375 inches of clear space needs to surround the logo to separate it from other elements, such as logos and symbols. This area, referred to as the area of non-interference, will preserve the visual impact and legibility of the logo.

Minimum Size: The minimum size of the Kahuina logo is shown below. The minimum size allows for maximum legibility at a small scale.

LOGO USE ON COLOR

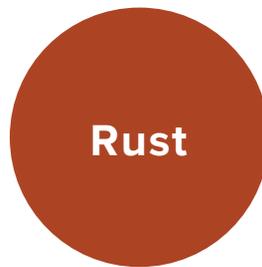

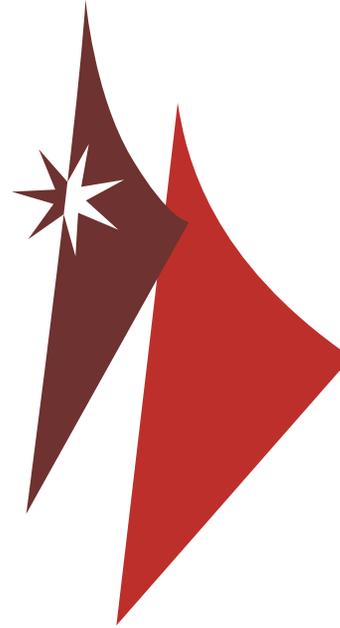

CLEAR SPACE & MINIMUM SIZE

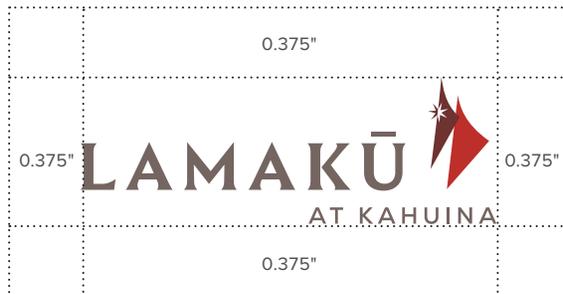

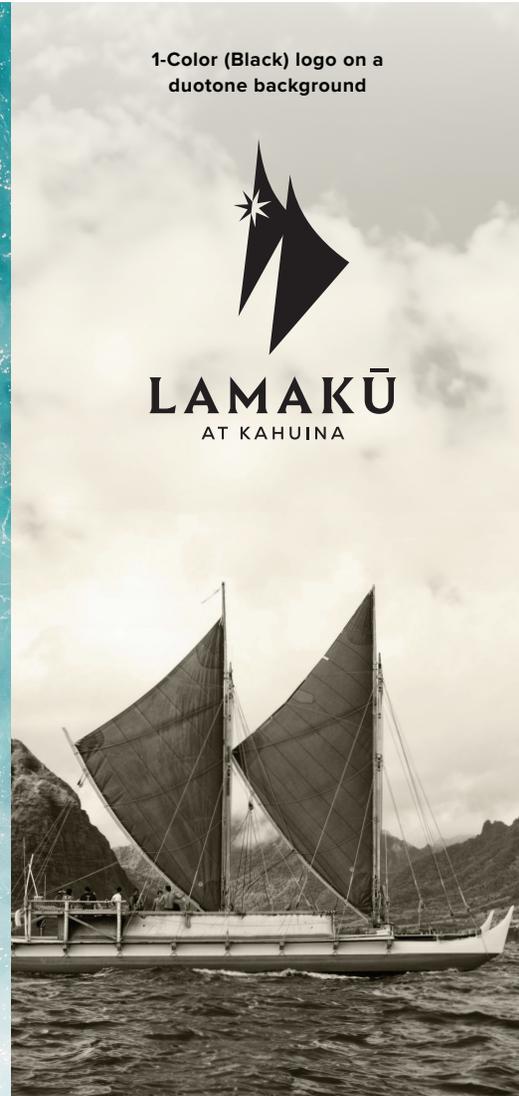

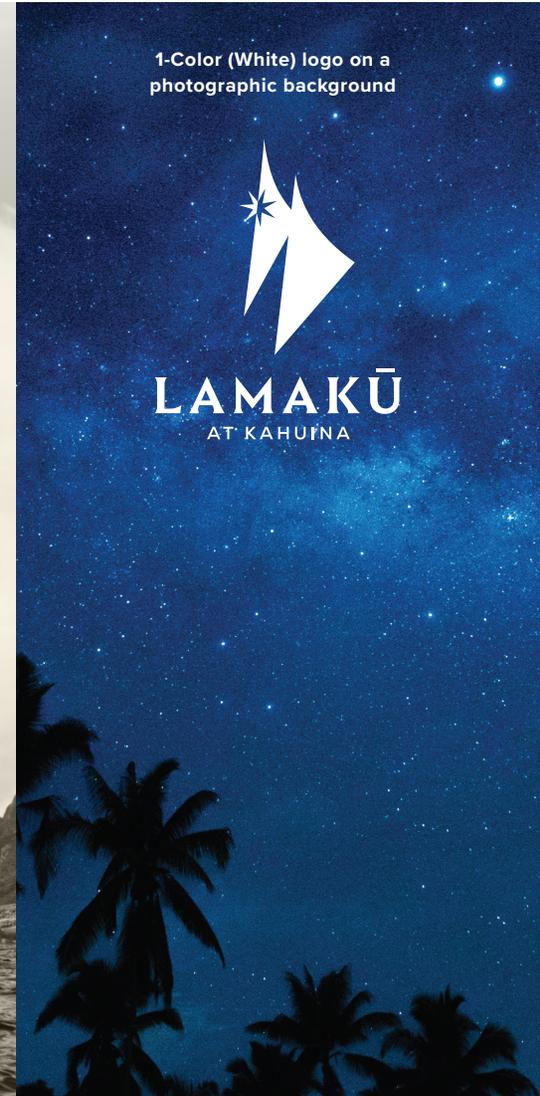

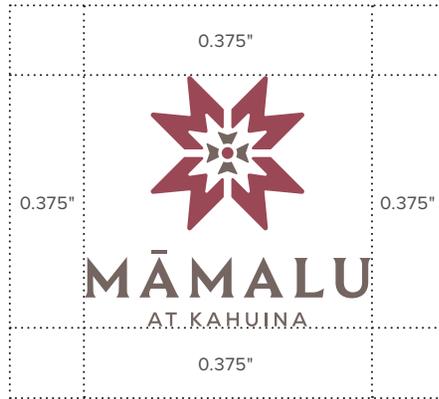
